Location: 1 block west of Giant market off North Atherton Street, State College. Enter gardens from Parkcrest Lane off Martin Street. Plots are adjacent to unpainted wooden barn. Watch for directional signs on Martin Street and Parkcrest Lane.

Garden Rules and Regulations

- 1. The rental fee for the garden plots (20 feet by 30 feet) is \$25.00. This amount is non-refundable. Half plots (20 feet by 15 feet) are \$15.00.
- 2. You are responsible for the maintenance of your plot / plots and will forfeit your plot if you do not meet the following requirements:
 - Weeds within the plot must be kept under control and must not exceed 6 inches in height.
 - There is to be no trash or debris in your plot (plastic bags, empty planters, plastic jugs, etc.).
 - There is to be no illegal plants grown in your plot.
- 3. There will be garden maintenance checks every three weeks or "weed checks." Gardeners will be notified via email (or phone) if there plot is in need of maintenance.
- 4. No pets allowed in gardens. Pets outside gardens <u>MUST</u> be on a leash.
- 5. Please be courteous to your fellow gardeners:
 - Park so that you do not block other cars. Avoid wet areas.
 - Do not let your weeds spread into your neighbors garden.
 - Do not pick food from any garden but your own.
 - Do not play loud music that may disrupt the peace of those gardening near you.
- 6. Raised beds: This method is fine, but please do not dig deep trenches and large mounds in your garden (for plowing purposes).
- 7. Rocks and large stones: Do NOT bring these into your plot. Do not use rocks to define the border of your plot.
- 8. Please drive slowly and carefully as there are many small children near the plots.
- 9. DO NOT LEAVE YOUR TOOLS AT THE GARDEN. We have experienced tool theft in the past and have no way of protecting your tools. Getting to know the gardeners near your plot and being aware of strangers and suspicious activities will help reduce garden pilferage. Please report any suspicious people and activities to Ferguson Township Police and any instance of theft.
- 10. Water and compost will be provided. Some stakes will be available. Some garden tools will also be available for those choosing to walk or bike to garden.
- 11. We are planning a picnic area in the shade of a 170 year old beautiful oak tree, next to the gardens!
- 12. Tudek Park Community Gardens is not liable for injuries that may occur at garden sites.
