

Homestead Park Playground Now Open to the Public!

Installation of a new playground at Homestead Park is now complete for residents and families to enjoy!

The **playground was under construction** until spring of 2022, and minor modifications were recently finalized to allow for safe use of the facilities. The orange plastic fencing around the playground has been removed and the playground is now available for public use.



The newly constructed playground is the first in Ferguson Township to feature a poured-inplace fall surface, which is shock absorbent and provides cushioning for potential falls from users of the playground.

The Ferguson Township Public Works Department asks that parents inform children to avoid the areas around the playground being planted with grass and avoid areas laid with hay. These areas are prone to being muddy, and will cause the playground to become dirty if children play in these areas and use the new playground.

Managing Spongy Moth Populations in Pennsylvania

Spongy moths, formerly known as "Gypsy Moths", or by their scientific




name, Lymantria dispar (L.), are present in Central Pennsylvania, and are considered pests by many environmentalist groups. According to the **Pennsylvania Department of**

Conservation and Natural Resources, "The spongy moth has been causing significant forest damage in Pennsylvania since the 1970s. The most recent outbreak occurred from 2013 to 2019 and another outbreak occurred from 2021 through 2022."



Pine Grove Mills Mobility Study Presentation by McCormick Taylor & Ferguson Township

At the Board of Supervisors Regular Meeting hosted on June 7, 2022, a draft version of the Pine Grove Mills Mobility Study was presented to the Board of Supervisors by the working group representatives from Ferguson Township and **McCormick Taylor Inc**.

The objective of the Pine Grove Mills Mobility Study was, "to evaluate the



transportation issues, concerns, and opportunities identified in the Pine Grove Mills Small Area Plan and identify concepts and recommendations to address those items and improve overall safety and mobility."

Acceptance of Retirement Resignation: Chief of Police, Chris Albright

At the Board of Supervisors Regular Meeting held on June 21, 2022, Chief of Police, Chris Albright, provided the Board of Supervisors with his resignation notice.

Chief Albright has worked with the Ferguson Township Police Department for 30 years, and was appointed as Police Chief in 2017. He is a lifelong resident of Ferguson Township, and will continue to reside the Centre Region upon retirement.

Chief Albright's final days as Chief of Police will be in late August or early September.

A search for a new Police Chief will begin after only two searches have been conducted in the last 20 years for this position. Ferguson Township will continue to update residents on this search as it unfolds.

We wish Chief Albright the best on his welldeserved retirement, and hope to see him present in the community as he transitions out of his official role!



Ferguson Township Police & Alpha Fire Company Host Fire Safety Event at Baileyville Community Hall

On Saturday, June 11, 2022, Alpha Fire Company and Ferguson Township Police Department hosted a Fire Safety Event at the Baileyville Community Hall.

Representatives from the Centre Region Code Office spoke about fire safety, and staff from Swartz Fire & Safety, Inc. evaluated old fire extinguishers, refilled serviceable units and sold new fire extinguishers and smoke detectors.

All food vendors that would like to operate a food truck in the Township should obtain approval from the Department of Planning & Zoning.


Terraced Streetscape District Rewrite (Ferguson Township -State College Boundary)

The Terraced Streetscape District (TSD) is a mixed-use corridor along West College Avenue (State Route 26) from the boundary of State College Borough (Buckhout Street) to the intersection of Blue Course Drive. While the rest of the Township saw significant development in the last decade, the TSD saw minimal development since the implementation of the TSD zoning and design standards.

Mackin Engineers & Consultants, along with Ferguson Township, will engage in this rewrite and plan for a series of public meetings in the future for citizen input. Ferguson Township will inform residents of these future meetings for public engagement on this project.
