term rentals with some restrictions. The regulations are intended to balance the economic opportunity created by Short **Term Rentals**



Turf Management Credit for Stormwater Fee

Property owners can apply for a 15% credit toward their stormwater fee by conducting a soil test on their property. As a reminder, credit and exemption



applications are due by September 30, 2021.
