UPDATES FOR NON-LIFE SUSTAINING BUSINESS & FOOD ESTABLISHMENT OWNERS AND MANAGERS

State College, PA – On Thursday, March 19, 2020, Pennsylvania Governor Tom Wolf ordered that all non-essential businesses be closed effective at 8:00 pm with enforcement beginning over the weekend to slow the spread of COVID-19. This was extended to Non-Life Sustaining Businesses by the Governor to Monday, March 23 at 8:00 a.m. More information regarding the Governor's response can be found at this website: www.governor.pa.gov.
