A PROCLAMATION OF THE TOWNSHIP OF FERGUSON, CENTRE COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA TO OFFICIALLY RECOGNIZE 2022 POLICE WEEK

Whereas, National Police Week, held every year in May, was created in 1962 through a proclamation issued by then-President John F. Kennedy, which designated the week of May 13-19, 1962, as Police Week; and
