FERGUSON TOWNSHIP PUBLIC WORKS WEEK MAY 15 – MAY 21, 2022

Whereas, public works infrastructure, facilities and services are of vital importance to the health, safety and well-being of the people of this nation; and

Whereas, such facilities and services could not be provided without the dedicated efforts of public works professionals representing all levels of government, who are responsible for and must design, build, operate, and maintain the transportation, water supply, wastewater systems, public buildings, and other facilities essential to serve our citizens; and

Whereas, it is in the public interest for the citizens and civic leaders of this country to gain knowledge of and to maintain a progressive interest in the public works needs and programs of their respective communities, and also to acknowledge the efforts public works professionals make to significantly improve the quality of life for communities, large and small

Whereas, the American Public Works Association has designated the week of May 15 to May 21 to be National Public Works Week and announced the theme of "Ready and Resilient" in order to emphasize that public works crews are "always ready to serve their communities, and resilient as ever in their abilities to pick themselves up off the ground after encountering challenges."

**Row, therefore, the Ferguson Township Board of Supervisors does hereby designate the week of May 15-21, 2022, as National Public Works Week in Ferguson Township; and urges all Township residents to join with the Township Board of Supervisors in recognizing the substantial contributions Public Works personnel have made to our national health and welfare.
