



OVERVIEW:

- Scattered showers and thunderstorms will affect NW PA this afternoon and evening ahead of an approaching cold front.
- Damaging winds are the primary threat, but a brief tornado is also possible.

TIMING	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ▪ Most likely timing for damaging winds: 2PM – 11PM Friday. ▪ Tornado risk will be highest Friday evening in northwest PA.
HAZARDS & IMPACTS	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ▪ Locally strong to damaging wind gusts are the primary threat and may result in downed trees and wires. ▪ Abnormally dry weather so far in October should preclude any flooding concerns across the area.
ADDITIONAL INFORMATION	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ▪ Additional showers and thunderstorms are expected Friday night into Saturday associated with a strong cold front. ▪ A few storms could be strong to severe Saturday afternoon.
POST-EVENT OUTLOOK	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ▪ Cooler and breezy this weekend. ▪ Lake-effect rain showers expected in NW PA.
