Watershed Cleanup Day: April 22



On March 21, 2023, the Board of Supervisors adopted a proclamation designating April 22, 2023, as Watershed Cleanup Day.

Also falling on Earth Day, Watershed Cleanup Day is an important effort to promote the protection of our local water resources and environmental conservation.

For this day, ClearWater Conservancy has organized numerous cleanup events at locations around Centre County, including the Slab Cabin Run, which flows through Pine Grove Mills.

The event will take place on April 22, 2023 from 8:00 a.m. until 12:00 p.m.

For those who wish to volunteer specifically for the Slab Cabin Run cleanup, participants will meet at Pine Grove Hall at 8:00 a.m. on the day. This effort meets one of the Pine Grove Mills Small Area Plan's goals of prioritizing green initiatives in the area.

Fairbrook Park Master Plan Adopted

On March 21, 2023, the Board of Supervisors adopted the Fairbrook Park Master Plan. The Plan serves as an overall blueprint for improvements and changes that will be prioritized for future work on the park.

Fairbrook Park is a 29-acre park located at 1210 Tadpole Road, Pennsylvania Furnace, PA 16865 on the south side of Whitehall Road between Tadpole Road and the Fairbrook Subdivision.

Signs in the Right of Way

The 2023 Municipal Primary Election is coming up on May 16. Leading up to election day, residents are reminded that, under Ferguson Township's Sign & Billboard Ordinance, political signs are considered "personal expression signs" which are permitted in the Township and do not require a sign permit.



However, please note that residential lots may have up to three temporary signs in the yard, and personal expression signs are only allowed in your yard; they are not permitted in the Township's Right of Way (ROW).

The ROW is the area between the sidewalk and the street. In areas with no sidewalk, the ROW is typically the area between the utility poles and the street.

Bicycle Safety

With nicer weather upon us, we will be seeing an increase in cyclists hitting the streets.

Motorists are reminded to always approach cyclists at a reduced speed and leave at least four feet of space when passing. Remember to check rear view and side mirrors for approaching cyclists before opening your vehicle's door.

Cyclists should always wear a helmet and bright and reflective clothing. Use side and rear reflectors, as well as a front lamp to increase visibility. Be sure to use appropriate hand and arm gestures when turning or stopping to notify motorists of your intentions.
