Draft 2024-2028 Capital Improvement Plan

Ferguson Township's Draft 2024-2028 Capital Improvement Plan (CIP) is available for public review.

The CIP helps guide the development of the Annual Operating Budget and enables the Board to prioritize expenditures based on need and financial stability. Updated annually, the CIP focuses on capital items, which are defined as having a cost greater than \$2,500 and an expected life of longer than one year. In addition to identifying expenditures, the CIP also depicts the Township's financial outlook over the next five years.

In place of the regular Planning Commission meeting scheduled for August 14, 2023, a joint Planning Commission and Board of Supervisors meeting will be held to continue the discussion of the Terraced Streetscape District rewrite. Stay Safe as Temperatures Rise

Extended exposure to extreme summer heat poses a number of health risks. The Ferguson Township Police would like to share a few tips to keep residents safe this summer.

- Drink a lot of water.
- High heat and humidity cause the body to work extra hard to maintain a normal temperature. Stay indoors with air conditioning.
- Watch for heat cramps, heat exhaustion, and heat stroke. The Centers for Disease Control and Prevention provides a list of symptoms and first aid steps for heat related illnesses. Call 911 if you see someone suffering from a heat emergency.
- Never leave children or pets alone in hot vehicles! Heat can rise in a car, up to 20 degrees in just 10 minutes!
- Check on family, friends, and neighbors who do not have air conditioning and who spend much of their time alone.

Speed Limit Reduced to 35mph on Section of Blue Course Drive



The speed limit of the eastbound section of Blue Course Drive between Westwind Drive and Circleville Road has been reduced from 45pmh to 35pmh.

On June 20, 2023, the Board of Supervisors voted to adopt an ordinance to amend Chapter 15, Motor Vehicles, Part 2, Traffic Regulations, Section 201 to reduce the speed limit.

This comes as a result of an existing bus stop on eastbound Blue Course Drive which will be moved to the west side of Circleville

Road. With the relocation, the Township Engineer conducted a traffic study to ensure the roadway meets the criteria for the reduced speed limit.

Construction at Suburban Park

Work is anticipated to start at Suburban Park on July 31, 2023. The proposed work consists of removing the existing drainage culvert and relocating the stream to the south along with other stormwater upgrades, new concrete kiosk area at the existing parking lot with a kiosk and bike rack, asphalt perimeter path and connecting paths with a connection to the regional bike route, new pavilion with horseshoe pits, outdoor fitness exercise equipment, four bridges, and perimeter plantings at the southern and eastern property lines.



While work is being performed, the tennis courts, play area, and pavilion will remain open; however, alternate parking will need to be sought as the on-lot parking area will be closed to the public. The park can be accessed from Vairo Boulevard (to the north) and East Aaron Drive to the south of the park. Alternate parking locations would be on Marjorie Mae Street off Vairo Boulevard or along East Aaron Drive to the south. Special attention should be provided to no parking locations.

In the March e-newsletter the Ferguson Township Tree Commission provided a summary of the public tree inventory conducted in 2022. As noted in that article, the reason for the tree inventory is to accurately account for the Township's publicly maintained trees because they represent an ecosystem service investment benefiting current and future residents. Managing this investment requires periodic census surveying of each tree to ensure tree health and public safety.

In addition to the inventory, a **Tree Canopy Assessment** was also conducted under the guidance of the Township's Public Works Director, David Modricker, PE with input from Township Arborist Larry Maginnis and Tree Commission Chairperson Dr. Marc McDill. The purpose of the tree canopy assessment is to measure the extent of our community's urban tree resource and how it is changing. This will help inform the Township's policies for managing both private and public trees. The canopy study used arial and satellite imagery collected in 2008 and 2019. Township Geographic Information System (GIS) specialists used GIS technology to visualize and calculate public tree canopy gains and loss across the Township in parks and Township right-of-ways. In addition, this analysis also enabled calculation of public and privately owned tree canopy gains and losses at a neighborhood level. This analysis informs such actions as planting decisions and forecasting Township maintenance activities.

On behalf of the Township Tree Commission, Arborist, Public Works Director, Township Manager and Board of Supervisors, along with future generations of Township residents we thank residents for their stewardship of the private and public trees. Our Township trees are more than a financial investment in property value; they are valued community members. Beyond beauty, shade and erosion control they provide multiple ecosystem services to people and wildlife.
