#### **Bicycle Safety**



As more cyclists hit the roads during this lovely spring weather, this is a reminder of basic precautions for motorists and riders alike.

Motorists should be sure to allow at least 4 feet of space when passing a cyclist on the road. Slow down when approaching a cyclinst and do not attempt to overtake on a hill or a turn. Wait until the road ahead is visibly clear.

Cyclists are urged to wear a helmet, and all riders under the age of 12 are required by law to do so. Wear vibrant colors, and use reflectors with a head light, especially between sunset to sunrise.

## **Public Works News**

#### **Micro-Surfacing Work**

Multiple streets in the vicinity of Hunters Chase, Turnberry, Middle Street, Park Center Boulevard, Old Gatesburg Road, and Morengo Road in Ferguson Township are currently undergoing micro-surfacing.

Micro-surfacing is a process in which a liquid-oil and crushed rock mixture is applied in two applications to asphalt pavement. This process protects the surface of the road from the effects of natural aging and the environment caused by inclement weather, excessive heat and the searing effects of the sun.

During the mirco-surfacing process, streets being worked on will have one lane closed at a time, and affected residents have already been notified of the work.

The project is projected to take two weeks to complete but is weather dependent.

#### **Pine Grove Mills Light Conversion Work**

Work on the Pine Grove Mills Street Light Conversion project began in early June and is scheduled for completion this fall.

The project involves rewiring existing ornamental lights in Pine Grove Mills and installing new power supplies and new power cutoffs to allow them to be serviced by Ferguson Township Public Works. Work will be performed on Nixon Road and East Pine Grove Road. There will be no road closures, but flaggers may be used to direct traffic as needed.

The lights in the work zone will be out of service for the duration of the project.

## Presentation on the Municipal Separate Storm Sewer System and Ferguson Township's Stormwater Management Program

On June 6, 2023, Ferguson Township Stormwater Engineer Aaron Jolin presented to the Board of Supervisors on the Municipal Separate Storm Sewer System (MS4) and Ferguson Township's Stormwater Management Program.

Mr. Jolin's presentation highlighted the importance of stormwater management in maintaining the Township's MS4 Permit.

Given this current dry spell, please consider looking out for private and public trees as you would for neighbors and animals that would be susceptible to exposure to high heat and lack of water.

Here are a few tips:

- For every inch of diameter of tree, provide 10 gallons of water every week. Here are some helpful watering tips from the Arbor Day Foundation. Arbor Day Watering Tips
- To avoid susceptibility to pathogens, avoid pruning while trees are heat/water stressed. If pruning is necessary, avoid pruning more than 15 percent at one time.
- Consider contacting a Certified Arborists to come inspect your trees and provide recommendations for treatment. If unsure whether you can afford their services, they can let you know whether estimates are free.
- If you see public street trees that appear to be rapidly declining in health, potentially suffering a disease, or pose a safety hazard please contact the Township Arborist at 814-238-4651 or email at arborist@twp.ferguson.pa.us.
