

#### Township Road Crew Works Towards Roads Scholar Certification

Ferguson Township road crew staff recently took part in multiple training sessions on stormwater facilities, maintenance, and drainage. The trainings are funded by PennDOT through the Local Technical Assistance Program (LTAP) and teach road-related technologies and innovations to better manage and maintain the Township's roadways.


**SCHEDULE & GUIDELINES**
