Ferguson Township Says Thank You to Chief of Police

Chief of Police, Chris Albright, submitted his retirement resignation to the Board of Supervisors at their June 21 regular meeting.

Throughout his 30 years of service to the Ferguson Township Police Department, Chief Albright strived to enhance the quality of life throughout the Township by working cooperatively to preserve the peace, enforce the law, reduce the fear and incidence of crime and provide a safe environment for the residents and visitors of the community.



A lifelong Ferguson Township resident, he officially began as Chief of Police on

June 30, 2017. Before becoming Chief, he served as second in command of the Police Department. A graduate of State College Area High School, Chief Albright earned a degree from Penn State and a Masters of Science degree in Security Management from Bellevue University. His many roles in the Ferguson Township Police Department included traffic detail, bike patrol, hostage negotiator, field training officer, and member of the tactical response team. He also managed the department's vehicle fleet, handled internal investigations, and conducted background checks for new hires.

Chief Albright will officially retire mid-November and respectfully requests the Township not publicly acknowledge his retirement in the form of a special event. "It is difficult to accept his request, I will honor and respect his wishes. On behalf of Ferguson Township, we thank Chief Albright for his dedication and service to Ferguson Township Police Department for 30 years," said Township Manager Martin. Sgt. Hendrick will serve as the Officer In Charge (OIC) beginning end of business day on Friday, August 26, until Chief Albright's official last day which is expected to be on November 18, 2022.

Ferguson Township is now accepting applications for the Chief of Police. The Township seeks a police professional committed to community engagement with an inclusive approach both inside the police department and Ferguson Township as well as within the Centre Region. The Chief will possess interpersonal skills and demonstrated leadership and management experience in law enforcement. The application deadline is September 23.

Township Manager Martin executed an agreement with GovHr to assist with the recruitment of the Chief of Police. The recruitment process has been underway since July 20th with the input and comments provided by approximately twenty-two (22) stakeholder interviewees, as well as a community input survey. The recruitment will involve a national search as well as local and regional. It is anticipated that the process will take approximately three months and there will be an opportunity for stakeholders to meet the finalists. Interviews of the finalists are anticipated to take place at the end of October with the intent that a candidate will be selected and able to begin with the Township in early December.



Oak Wilt Strikes

Ferguson Township's first case of oak wilt in 2022 has been confirmed. Two infected trees on a property on Beaver Branch Road were inspected by the Township's Arborist, Larry Maginnis.

Oak wilt is a fungal disease that affects oak trees in the area. Infected trees cannot be cured, and signs of the disease must be identified early to prevent spreading to other nearby trees.
