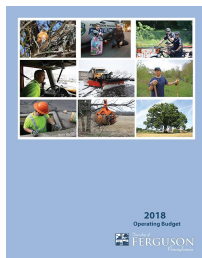
Community volunteers sought to serve on new Parks and Recreation Committee

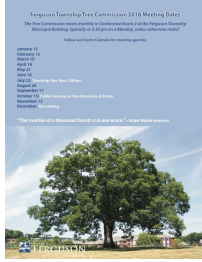

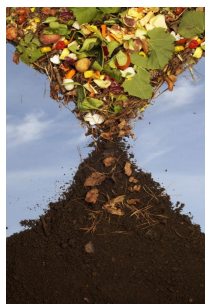
