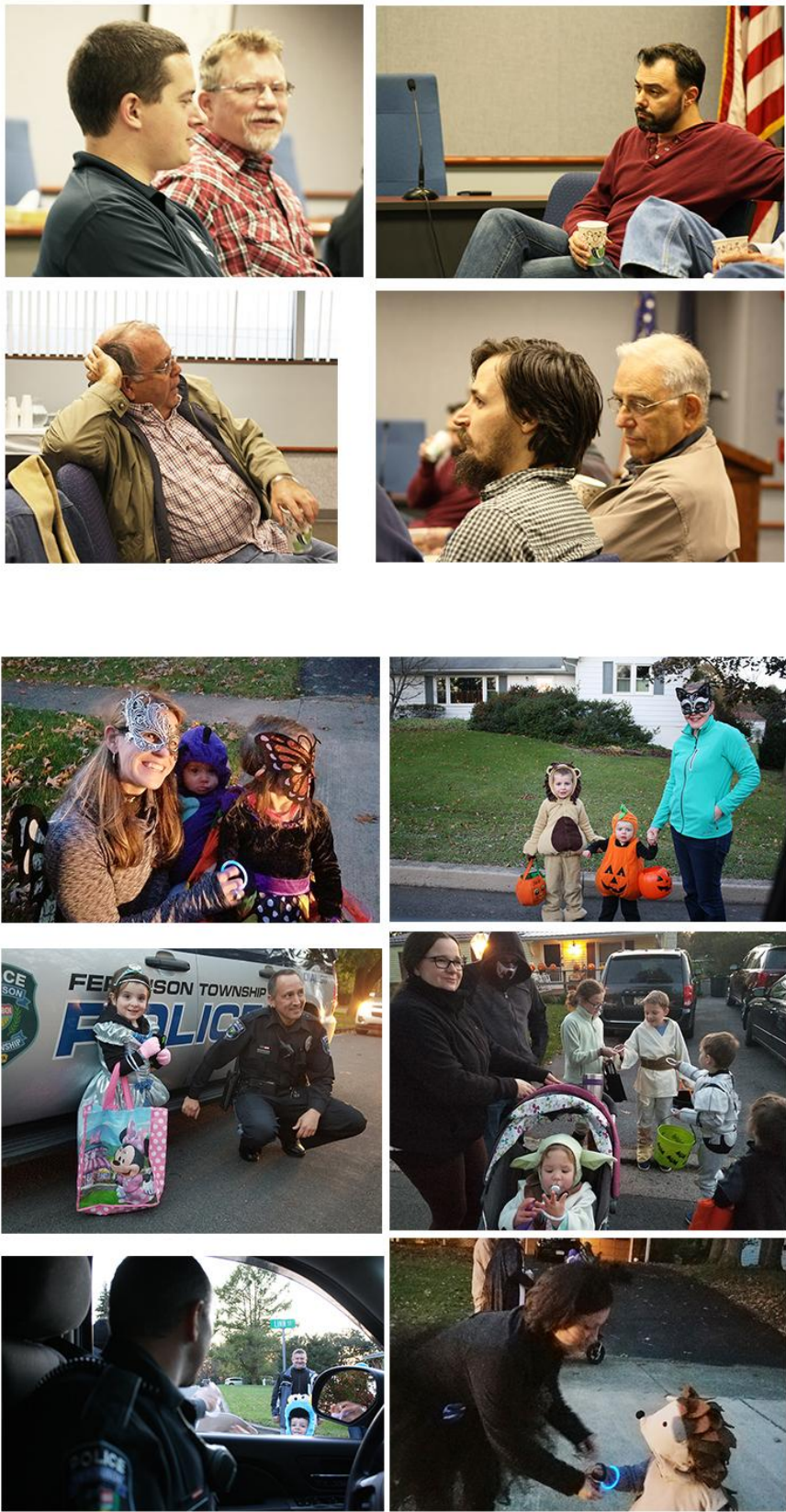
University Area Joint Authority (UAJA) Compost Facility
